CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

In summary, modernism is an understanding that emerged since the rise of western society from the dark ages to the enlightenment ages, the industrial ages and the scientific ages. The characteristics of the modern era are the development of a scientific outlook on life colored by the notions of secularism, rationalism, empiricism, dichotomous ways of thinking, desacralization, pragamatism and the denial of metaphysical truths.

So, the essence of modernism is secularism, rationalism, empiricism, dichotomous way of thinking, desacralization, pragmatism and denial of

metaphysical truth. Apart from that, he also explained that there is another model of post-modern worldview which was born as a protest against modernism. Post modernism is different from modernism because it has shifted to new ideas such as nihilism, relativism, pluralism and gender equality and is generally anti-worldview (Zarkasyi, 2009: 36-37). In this case, a continuation of modernism maintains the notions of liberalism, rationalism and pluralism which unite and influence the development of postmodernism thought.

Based on the analysis above, it is certain that the conditions for the truth of life views are different. Sometimes these views on life clash with each other which results in different assumptions of truth so that it is very important to search texts about views on life and truth through a humanistic approach to be critical to the truth conditions.

According to (Boggs, 1991):

In this approach, called the humanistic approach, focusing attention on the statement the movie makes, that is moral, philosophical, and social statement. because the best movies are built around statement that teaches us something. In this kind of evaluation, we must determine if the acting and the character have significance or meaning beyond the context of the movie itself significance in moral, social, or philosophical sense that help us gain a clearer understanding of some aspect of life, human nature, or the human condition. We judge the movie as an expression of an idea that has intellectual, moral, social, or culturan importance and the ability to somehow influence our lives for the better. Acting, cinematography, lighting, editing, sound, and so on are all judged in terms of how effectively they contribute to the communication of the movie's message, and the overall value of the movie depends on the significance of its theme. We might consider these questions when using the humanistic approach to evaluate a movie: (1) what statement does the movie make, and how significance the "truth" we learn from it?; (2) how effectifely do the different movie elements communicate the movie's message?; (3) how does the movie attempt to influence our lives for the better?; (4) What benefits and actions does it attempt to change?; (5) is the message stated by the movie universal, or is it restricted to our own time and place?; (6) how relevant is the theme to our own experience?

Therefore evaluating and analyzing movies is very important to do in order to reveal: (1) the truth value (2) the movie's message (3) the benefits of the movie (4) the impact of the movie in our lives. Besides, movie is also useful as an educational medium because it can influence a person's behavior and mindset, especially in English Language Education.

In this research, the researchers used a sci-fi movies. science is the most obvious and influential form of futuristic thought in the populer culture. As a futuristic story, sci-fi resonates with psychological predisposition to give meaning and purpose to life through stories; enabling the person to fully immerse himself in the future; and stimulating all major aspects of future consciousness (Tom, 2015), This means that science fiction is a story depicting a future with the sophistication of technology and science fiction movie can spark the audience's curiosity about all that remains mystery or science/technology today has not reached. Science fiction movie related to future stories, outside travel, science experiments, time explore, invade or destroy the earth (Sudjadi, 2015).

Science fiction can be classified into two modes, experimental and conventional. Experimental mode is tied to science while conventional mode is completely tied to mythology (Lau and Hung, 2005). On the other hand, conventional fashion referred to science fiction as an entertainment commodities that target more readers, or audiences, rather than objective analysis.
